BIO

Moosters was formed in 2002 by four old friends who all had a love for blues in common. Initially they were just planning to do one show at a party. But after rehearsing a while and playing that gig they all felt that this was something serious!

The name Moosters is not just similar to the name of a huge four legged creature with horns, it's also a way to express in Swedish that something sounds mashed, (Mos = Mashed Potatoes in Swedish) which everyone in the band thought was a great way to describe their sound! The band grew tighter and got more and more gigs all over Sweden.

Later that year they got in contact with people from the festival "On The Waterfront", the largest music festival in the state of Illinois, who invited the band to play the festival in the summer of 2003. On top of that the festival also helped the band book a short 8-gig tour around Illinois. So in the summer of 2003 Moosters took the Blues back home!

Moosters really rocked in the States, and the Americans were very enthusiastic about Moosters and their music. They were immediately invited for another tour in 2004, with 2 larger festivals and 8 club gigs.

It was sometime in-between the two US tours that Moosters started to write their own material and the thoughts of making an album started forming. In the end of 2005 Moosters went into the studio and recorded what will become their full length debut "Executioner". The band also got themselves a manager to help them in their career. They decided that they would release the album themselves and not go through a label.

MEMBERS

Dave Nerge - vocals/harmonica

Dave moved to Sweden from Chicago in his early 20's and soon became a well-known personality. Dave's performed with **Elvis Costello, Dave and the Mistakes, The Boogie Kings, Mick Ronson, Johnny Thunders** and more. Besides music, Dave also works with radio, TV, film and media. You don't need to be TALL to be BIG! Dave is a powerful, fun-loving front man, and, a hilarious, entertaining showman. Let the good-times roll!

Pelle Alsing - drums

Pelle is one of Sweden's definitive premiere session and tour drummers for over 20 years. He hits 'em very hard and he hits 'em very true. When he's not performing with Moosters, Pelle's in the studio pulling triple-rate or touring and playing with the Swedish super group **Roxette**, and, ladies, he's quite the HOTTY!

Kjell Segebrant - guitar/vocals

Rumor has it that when God created the Stratocaster he had Kjell (pronounced "Shell") in mind, and, as a matter of biblical-fact, He was contemplating calling it The Kjellocaster. Kjell is one of the most respected and awed premier session and tour guitarists in Scandinavia. Kjell has worked with the artists **Ian Hunter, Mick Ronson, Graham Parker** and more. Kjell is a true, bone-fide guitar-slinger. He's so hot you'll think he's from another dimension. But, buried deep within this Monster's lies a heart made of solid blue. You've not seen or heard anything like Kjell before!

Hans Derestam - bass

Hans, a.k.a, The Captain, is The Master of LOW. Hans has been the backbone of one of the hardest working blues bands in Scandinavia - **Blues Bag**, for ages. Nobody goes as low as The Captain. Many consider him the optimal three-piece bass-player. Hans has also worked with Earl Thomas, Alan Haynes and more. Hans's motto is: "If you wanna reach the top, you gotta have a working relationship with THE BOTTOM" He's the worlds only 1100 watt, dual-channel Pacemaker.
